NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS, the National Coordination Committee (NCC) under the chair of Prime Minister of Pakistan during its meeting held on 07.05.2020 decided to cancel the Boards' examinations across the country owing to COVID-19 Pandemic.

WHEREAS, the Board of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Board of Technical Education, on the basis of guidelines decided by the Inter Provincial Education Ministers' Conference in its meeting dated 14.05.2020, finalized the "Draft Policy for the promotion of students of Diploma of Associate Engineer (DAE)/Diploma of Commerce (D.Com)/Diploma of Business Administration (DBA)" without examinations in its meeting dated 10.06.2020 due to the cancellation of Annual Examinations 2020 in the Backdrop of COVID-19 Pandemic" for consideration of the Government.

AND WHEREAS, the Government has been pleased to approve "Policy for the promotion of students of Diploma of Associate Engineer (DAE)/Diploma of Commerce (D.Com)/Diploma of Business Administration (DBA) due to Cancellation of Annual Examinations 2020 in the Backdrop of COVID-19 Pandemic".

NOW THEREFORE, the decision regarding cancellation of examination and the "Policy for the promotion of students of Diploma of Associate Engineer (DAE)/Diploma of Commerce (D.Com)/Diploma of Business Administration (DBA) without examinations due to Cancellation of Annual Examinations 2020 in the Backdrop of COVID-19 Pandemic" are hereby notified for implementation by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Board of Technical Education with immediate effect as laid here-in-after;

A. Final year students of DAE programme:

- i. Results of DAE 3rd year students in case of 3-years diploma and DAE 4th year students in case of 4-years diploma who have passed all their previous examinations, shall be drawn on the basis of marks percentage in theory & practical subjects obtained by the students in their previous year's exam. Additional marks equal to 3% of the total marks obtained by them in their previous year's exam shall be added to their aggregate marks.
- ii. The compart papers of the concerned students in their previous DAE 1st, 2nd and/or 3rd year shall be passed on minimum passing marks, provided the number of such failed subjects in number is not more that 40% of the total subjects in each of the above cited exams (total subjects shall include both theory & practical).
- iii. In case the number of failed subjects of students in their previous years' exam in number is more than 40% of the total subjects of the concerned exam, then such students shall have to appear in the special exam to be arranged between Sep-Nov, 2020. Results of such students will be drawn after they pass all their compart papers.

B. Current Students of DAE

- i. These students shall stand promoted to their next year of studies.
- ii. They shall appear in their Annual Examinations, 2021. After these students pass exams in the subjects of their next year of studies during the said exams, the marks percentage obtained by them in theory & practical subjects shall proportionately be converted for drawing results of their previous year of studies. Students failing to pass the cited exam shall have to appear in their failed subjects in the Board's subsequent exams. Results of their previous year shall accordingly be declared after they pass their failed subjects.
- iii. All those students, who have compart papers in their previous years' exam, shall appear in the above cited special exam.

C. Final Year Students of D.Com/DBA (Part-II)

- i. Results of D.Com/DBA final year (Part-II) students, who have passed their Part-I exam, shall be determined on the basis of marks percentage obtained by them in their previous year's exam (Part-I). Additional marks equal to 3% of the total marks obtained by the students in their previous year's exam shall be added to the aggregate marks.
- ii. The compart papers of the concerned students in their previous D.Com/DBA Exam (Part-I) shall be passed on minimum passing marks, provided the number of such failed subjects in number is not more that 40% of the total subjects of the previous year of studies.
- iii. In case the number of failed subjects of students in their previous years' exam in number is more than 40% of the total subjects of the concerned exam, then such students shall have to appear in the special exam as mentioned above. Results of such students will be drawn after they pass all their compart papers.

D. Current Students of D.Com/DBA (Part-I)

- i. These students shall stand promoted to their next year of Studies (Part-II). They shall appear in the Part-II of the D.Com/D.BA Annual Examinations, 2021.
- ii. Subject to passing of the Part-II exam, results of their previous class (Part-I) shall be drawn on the basis of marks percentage obtained by them in their Part-II exam.
- iii. Students having compart papers in Part-II Annual Exams, 2021, shall not be awarded 1st year DMC until they pass their compart papers of Part-II exam.

E. Ex-Compart Students of DAE/D.Com/DBA

The Ex-Compart students of DAE/D.Com/DBA having compart papers in their respective previous examinations shall be passed on minimum passing marks, provided they have submitted their examination forms for Annual Examinations, 2020 to KP-BTE by the cutoff date and further provided that such compart papers in number are not more than 40% of the total subjects of the concerned exams. This facility, however, shall not be extended to those students whose failed papers in one exam is less than 40% of the total subjects of that exam, while in another exam, his failed subjects are more than 40%. Such students may appear in the special exam to pass their compart papers.

F. Miscellaneous

- i. The promotion policy shall be applicable to those students whose application forms have been received as per notified schedule in the office of KP-BTE.
- ii. The scores of individual subjects for the 3rd year class of 3-Year DAE/DDM courses, 4thyear class of 4-year DAE course and Part-II of D.Com/ DBA shall not be mentioned in the transcripts. Only an aggregate score out of total marks and an overall grade based on the aggregate score will be awarded to the students for the qualifications.
- iii. The KP-BTE shall mention in the transcript and in the diploma/certificate that the marks awarded for final years is the best prediction of the performance and has been awarded based on the formulae and guidelines approved by the Government and recognized by IBCC.
- iv. Those students, who are not satisfied with the marks awarded to them and opt to appear in the special examination, may submit their consent to KP-BTE on its prescribed declaration form within 10 days of this notification.
